The pressures and realities of adult life often trigger substance use disorders. Whether to relieve anxiety or depression brought on or exacerbated by work, school, domestic life, finances, marital issues, social problems or other life circumstances, the self-medicating powers of alcohol and drugs are undeniably effective, until a problem develops. As they progress, substance use disorders not only make the problems being self-medicated worse, they begin to impact other areas of life, health and functionality.

Our clients represent persons of all ages, races, genders and walks of life. While the reasons and circumstances that lead them to us are invariably different, they share a common desire to get their lives back on track, and need practical, effective strategies to accomplish that.

The course and type of services we may recommend are tailored to the unique needs of our clients, as determined from a comprehensive evaluation and modified as needed on an ongoing basis.

Treatment and recovery support services are provided by a multi-disciplinary team of clinicians in the areas of counselling, psychiatry and nursing, who specialize in mental health and chemical dependence. Each of our clients is matched with a primary therapist beginning with the evaluation, who serve as their main guide throughout care. Our intake staff makes every effort to link clients with a primary therapist best suited to their needs. We do everything we can to help our clients prepare for life after treatment, and the challenges of long-term recovery. This requires addressing not only the fundamental causes of the problem, but also the addictive patterns and behaviors that are developed and honed over time. We help our clients explore the behavioral and learned aspects of their problem, and help them develop strategies to avoid their old rituals, routines and triggers.

This program can start while you are still in incarceration and continues through release and while on parole.

Check with your facility parole officer to see if you qualify while still incarcerated or your field parole officer to see if you can enroll in the program after you have been released. The Reentry Program works with you to create an Transitional Accountability Plan, which identifies your personal goals and needs. You will work with a Care Coordinator who will assist you with meeting the conditions of parole and the goals of the TAP by scheduling appointments with providers and identifying ways to overcome difficulties in areas of transportation, employment, family and more. Studies by such places as Stanford University have found that the first 72 hours are a critical and crucial time when you have the potential to seize the moment and lay good foundations for a new start.

You need to be connected with housing, counseling, employment, medical and other resources as quickly as possible. This is at a time when there may also be temptations and the potential to become overwhelmed or confused by the many choices available.
