Adults who have 60-364 days remaining in custody after serving at least 1/3 of their sentence; are not serving a sentence for a sex offense or a sexually violent offense; agree to monitoring for 6 months or the remainder of their sentences, whichever is longer. Voluntary program assists with changing behaviors that lead to incarceration includes case management, random substance screening, attending self-help meetings, and community service.
