Our "Nutshell" Year in Review:

- Presented our technology tools at a White House Workshop on Using Technology in Reentry
- Increased our Resource Directory to well over 15,000 and our <u>Reentry Packet</u> to nearly 90 pages!
- Heard from inmates in 3 different states who are using our Reentry Packet as a text book for reentry classes
- Connected directly with over 6000 inmates and 450 reentry professionals and educators around the country
- Officially launched our software application, including our Computer Basics tutorial
- Forged a collaborative relationship with the Ray Brook Reentry Initiative at FCI Ray Brook in upstate NY.
